Dear Parents and Carers,

From now until the end of term the children will be involved with activities relating to World Book Day, Red nose day and towards the end of term Springtime and Easter. The learning objectives will remain the same as before half term and these will have been uploaded to Tapestry by your child's key person for your information. The learning experiences offered will be adapted to suit the needs and interests of your child.

COVID UPDATES

The guidance for Covid-19 is changing all the time and we are all very aware of the need to keep everyone safe as possible whilst they are with us at Explorers. It now states: **There is no longer a legal requirement for people with coronavirus (COVID-19) infection to self-isolate, however if you have any of the main symptoms of COVID-19 or a positive test result, the public health advice is to stay at home and avoid contact with other people.**

The following advice is for:

- people with any of the main symptoms of COVID-19
- people who have received a positive COVID-19 lateral flow device (LFD) or polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test result
- people who live in the same household as, or who have had close contact with, someone who has COVID-19

This also applies to children and young people who usually attend an education or childcare setting.
